***Supplies needed: Plastic Baggies, Cotton Swabs, Permanent Marker, Fingerprint Pad, Current Wallet-Sized Photographs.***

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*If the "unthinkable" happens.....*

1. Immediately call 911 and local law enforcement agencies. When they arrive, present this Kit and insist they enter the information into the National Crime Information Computer (NCIC) at once.
2. If you suspect an abduction occurred, notify the F.B.I.
3. Notify all local media assignment desks. Work with them....keeping in mind the general public's awareness about missing children could be expedited by the broadcasting of details.
4. Notify the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children at 1 (800) The Lost.
5. Keep a responsible adult in your home at all times and record all telephone conversations. This may be the only way your child knows how to reach you.
6. Find a printer and post flyers in the local area.
7. Seek emotional and psychological support from your church and/or local service agencies if needed. Remember, you alone should lead the battle for the return of your child. Never Give Up Home!

# ***Do It Yourself Child's DNA Collection Kit***

## **HAIR**

To collect a hair sample, simply brush or comb your child's hair and use the remaining hair from the brush/comb. The root of the hair contains the DNA information. The hair sample **MUST** contain the root or follicle of the hair. After the hair has been collected, place in a plastic baggie. Label the bag with a permanent marker such as a Sharpie..

## **FINGERNAILS**

Simply place nail clippings inside a separate baggie. Label.

## **SALIVA**

Rub a clean cotton swab on the inside cheek until moist. Let the swab air dry for 24 hours then place inside separate baggie. Fold that bag inside another bag and seal. Label the outside bag.

## **BLOOD**

Follow the same procedures for the Saliva sample but wait until your child has a normal cut or scrape before taking the sample.

***Place the bags inside your freezer***

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


